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Fundraising on behalf of UNHCR is any kind of event, sale, or activity organized by people who want to support a specific cause or charity. These initiatives complement UNHCR's own fundraising activities, helping the organization to raise money for millions of refugees in need.

WHAT WILL THIS TOOLKIT DO?

The toolkit offers ideas for individuals, organizations and teams who want to plan their own fundraising initiative, but need some help getting started. It includes information on organizing an event or activity, sharing the news with your community and following up with participants once your fundraiser is complete.

You'll also find a variety of facts and figures about UNHCR that you can share with friends, family and other potential donors. These details can be great additions to social media campaigns, as well as to emails, flyers and event programs.

HOW TO SET UP A FUNDRAISING PAGE

You can build a safe and secure donation page right on the UNHCR Canada website. Anyone who uses it to make a gift will automatically receive a tax receipt.

Here's how to get started:

- 1. Read through this toolkit to learn more about UNHCR, effective fundraising, and procedures you need to follow when hosting an event.
- 2. Visit https://e-activist.com/p2p/unhcr/login to create your own event page.
- 3. Once you're registered, you can customize your own fundraising page and set a personal goal. We will be in touch once you register to see how we can help.
- 4. Share your page with friends, family, colleagues and classmates.
- 5. Include the URL in your emails, social media posts, flyers and media releases.
- 6. Check your page regularly to track donations to your campaign.
- 7. Have fun!

GET NOTICED TIPS AND TRICKS TO HELP YOU PROMOTE YOUR EVENT



THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO PROMOTE YOUR EVENT AT LITTLE TO NO COST.

Taking time to plan and try a few different forms of communication will help to spread news within your community.

Planning

Promotional campaigns usually start weeks ahead of an event. Consider who might be interested in contributing to your fundraiser, and how they might hear about it if they don't know you personally.

Create a list of people who can share information about your event, including friends, family, classmates, colleagues, reporters and members of your social networks.

Word of mouth

Get in touch with your contacts at least a month in advance to see if they can help you promote your fundraiser. Provide them with all the details they need so that it's easy for them to spread the word.

Online promotions

Social media platforms are excellent tools for sharing news and updates. On page 9, we provide some sample tweets and posts to help you start planning your campaign.

You might also want to find people from your community who share events with their social networks. Ask them if they would be willing to help you spread the word, and remember to thank them for posting your information.

Press coverage

If you're planning a large-scale fundraiser, you may want to connect with local media outlets like newspapers and TV and radio stations. Contact information for reporters and producers is often available online.

Members of the media will be looking for stories that are of interest to their audiences. Provide them with the date, time and location of your event, as well as details that will entice people to attend. You can also let them know about UNHCR by including this paragraph in your message:

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), also known as the UN Refugee Agency, is the world's leading organization aiding and protecting people forced to flee their homes due to violence, conflict and persecution.

UNHCR provides shelter, food, water, medical care and other life-saving assistance to refugees around the world. Their committed staff of 8,600 work in more than 125 countries—saving and protecting lives and building a better future for 16.7 million refugees, 33.3 million internally displaced people and 1.1 million asylum-seekers.



The size and scope of your fundraiser are completely up to you. You can collect pledges for your upcoming marathon or organize a 5K fun run for your neighbourhood—just remember to consider how much time you have to plan and what sorts of activities your community might enjoy.

PLANNING CHECKLIST

Make event-planning easy by staying organized with our Event Planning Checklist. Remember – organization is key to a successful event!

BEI	FORE YOUR EVENT
	Brainstorm event ideas – refer to our examples of community fundraising events for ideas.
	Contact UNHCR Canada to let us know about your event.
	Determine a date and location.
	Make a list of the supplies needed for your event.
	Approach vendors or business about donations or sponsorship.
	Reach out to friends and family for donations.
	Update your social media accounts and promote your event.
	Create a team of volunteers to help with the planning and execution of your event. Make sure you have assigned specific roles before your event.
	Contact media if you would like to invite them to your event.
	In case of deliveries, make sure to give enough notice and take shipping time into consideration.
	Make sure all materials with the UNHCR logo are approved.
DU	RING YOUR EVENT
	Have UNHCR Canada donation forms on hand for any donations made at the event.
	Have UNHCR Canada brochures on hand for your participants.
	Thank everyone for coming.
AF	TER YOUR EVENT
	Collect the funds and mail them to UNHCR Canada.
	Send thank you letters to your donors and volunteers – refer to our sample letters.
	Send in photos from your event.
	Let us know about your event!



SOCIAL MEDIA CAN HELP YOU CONNECT WITH MEMBERS OF YOUR COMMUNITY AND GENERATE INTEREST IN YOUR CAMPAIGN OR EVENT.

When you post . . .

Share your message with us by using the handle @UNHCRCanada.

Include photos and videos to capture people's attention.

Provide details that will get people excited about your event and about UNHCR.

Update your network regularly in the weeks and days leading up to the event. Remember to post during the event, as well, so that your online community feels included.

Thank your donors, sponsors and volunteers for their contributions. On the day of an event, include pictures to show how they're making it a success.

Use one or two hashtags (e.g., #refugee) to include your post in conversations about current events and your community.



UNHCR's efforts are mandated by the organization's Statute, and guided by the 1951 United Nations Convention relating to the Status of Refugees and its 1967 Protocol. International refugee law provides an essential framework of principles for UNHCR's humanitarian activities.

UNHCR is an impartial organization, offering protection and assistance to refugees and others on the basis of their needs and irrespective of their race, religion, political opinion or gender. In all of its activities, UNHCR pays particular attention to the needs of children and seeks to promote the equal rights of women and girls.

In its efforts to protect refugees and to promote solutions to their problems, UNHCR works in partnership with governments, regional organizations, international and non-governmental organizations. UNHCR is committed to the principle of participation, believing that refugees and others who benefit from the organization's activities should be consulted over decisions which affect their lives.

By virtue of its activities on behalf of refugees and displaced people, UNHCR also endeavours to promote the purposes and principles of the United Nations Charter: maintaining international peace and security; developing friendly relations among nations; and encouraging respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms.
